It has exceptional flavor and excellent storage characteristics, producing light uniform colored fries, and flavor when baked, boiled or microwaved.

Requires medium to high levels of Nitrogen and has medium resistance to metribuzin.

Weakness: Susceptible to *rhizoctonia*.
